NCQ Board Nominations

According to NCQ's constitution, there is a minimum of seven (7) and maximum of nine (9) board members. This must include three (3) ordinary members from metropolitan zones (Brisbane, Sunshine Coast and/or Gold Coast) and four (4) ordinary members from rural or regional Queensland.

This year NCQ has one (1) vacancy in Metropolitan Zone and two (2) vacancies in Rural/Regional Zone.

Existing members of the Committee are eligible for renomination.
